**Times:** Tentative ride times will be posted to website but may change up until the day of the show. Check show program for confirmed times.

**ENTRIES: Make checks payable to MDA.** Complete entries will be accepted in the order received. Failure to submit a complete entry form may result in you being placed on the wait list. Coggins and full payment must accompany entries. No entries accepted by phone or fax. Entries must be postmarked on the **OPENING** date or thereafter, up to and including the **CLOSING** date or until the show is full, whichever comes first. Please use entry blank provided. Make copies for additional entries or shows. Show committee reserves the right to limit entries, limit the classes per horse, to add, divide or cancel classes or make whatever changes required by circumstances of the competition. Each entry must be signed by the rider, owner of horse, trainer and parent if applicable.

**Footing:** 2 sand show arenas with excellent footing and drainage. 1 sand schooling arena. All are fenced. Management reserves the right to assign any Training level test to either a small or large arena. All Intro to be ridden in small arena.

**Dogs:** ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED AT ALL TIMES. For everyone's safety please consider leaving them at home

**Food:** An excellent concession stand is on the grounds

**Coggins: NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED FOR ALL HORSES:** within 12 months for MI horses & within 6 months for out-of-state horses. Must be presented before horse can be unloaded. **Name on Coggins must match Name of horse on entry form**

**CLASSES:** The 2007 USEF tests will be used. All tests may be read. Horses may be shown in only two consecutive levels regardless of the number of riders sharing the horse. (Example – Intro and training level or training and first level etc.) **Shows will be conducted under USEF rules unless other wise noted by show management. ASTM approved helmets must be worn by all riders at all times. Exception: Adults may file a waiver in the office.**
